

E. E. Kennemore, et al DEED TO D. S. Barker

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, Greenville County. KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the E. E. Kennemore and M. F. Kennemore in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Thirty six hundred no 00 Dollars, to us paid by D. S. Barker in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said D. S. Barker all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the City of Greenville, on President Street, near Furman University, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at the south eastern corner of Prof. W. H. Watson's line and running thence N. 5 1/2 E. 60 feet to stake; thence S. 8 3/4 E. 211 feet, more or less, to stake at corner of Prof. D. B. Moore's lot; thence North 60 feet along Moore's line to the south eastern corner of Watson's line; thence along Watson's line 204 feet to the beginning corner, reserving, however, to the said E. E. Kennemore and M. F. Kennemore, their heirs and assigns, the right in the use of an alleyway ten feet in width and one hundred feet in depth along the southern side of said lot, in common with the said D. S. Ballenger all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in the City of Greenville, on the South side of Earle Street, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake one hundred fifty feet from the southeast corner of Earle and Townes Streets; and running thence with Earle Street S. 84 1/2 E. fifty feet; thence S. 5 1/2 W. two hundred feet to a stake; thence N. 84 1/2 W. fifty feet to a stake; thence N. 5 1/2 E. two hundred feet to the beginning corner.
