 to me paid by Naomi Scott, of Greenville

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Naomi Scott all my right and interest, the usual heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in South Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

near the City of Greenville, on the old Paris Mountain Road, containing two acres, more or less: Beginning at an iron pin, Gabriel's Scott's corner, and running thence with this line N. 41 E. 5.43 chains to a stone, thence N. 19 W. with line of Jim Sims at W. H. Irvine 4.00 chains to a cedar tree; thence S. 41 W. with W. H. Irvine's line 5.35 chains to an iron pin on the Paris Mountain Road, and thence with said road S. 19 E. 4.00 chains to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to Gabriel Scott by Anna C. in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Logan Walker all that piece, parcel or lot of land in South Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

containing fourteen acres having the following notes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin 3X in White Horse Road, thence N. 89 E. 18.95 to stone 3X; thence N. 1/2 E. 6.25 to stone 3X; thence N. 87 W. 6.70 to a stone 3X; thence S. 22 1/2 W. 19.85 to an iron pin in the white Horse Road 3X; thence along the said road 3.50 to the beginning corner.
