in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. L. Cox, Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Containing fifty-one and one-half acres, more or less, joining lands now or formerly of MacLane Locke, John L. Smith, Lawrence Blakely, W. C. Smith and David Jones, on the Georgia and Reedy Ferry Roads, about one and one-half miles from Simpsonville.
