Thomas M. Walker All those six (6) certain lots of land situate on the north side of South Main Street in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known and designated as lots 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15 as shown on plat of property of Greenville Trust Company, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E., page 90, being a part of the property known as Chicora College property and having together the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on South Main Street, joint corner of lots 10 and 20 as shown on said plat and running thence with South Main Street S. 83-27 W. 75 ft.; thence still with South Main St., S. 85-01 W. 75 ft. to iron pin corner of lot No. 16; thence with line of lot 16, N. 10-38 W. 90 ft.; thence with rear line of lots 13, 14 and 15, N. 85-59 E. 75 ft.; thence with rear line of lots 10, 11 and 12, N. 83-27 E. 75 ft.; thence with line common to lots 10 and 20, S. 10-38 W. 90 ft. to the beginning corner.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$3,750.00) DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee...

That certain lot or parcel of land situate in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, known as, Tract #40, on plat #2 of the Parker Land Company, made by A. S. Bedell, April 1914; situated at the intersection of the Lipscomb and Parker roads, and bounded by tracts #43, 44, 42, 41, 68, and 69. 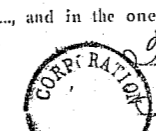
