a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and no. cents DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

J. W. Griffith, and his heirs and assigns, All those 16 certain lots, pieces, or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, near Piney Mountain, on Lauremont and Lake Drive, and being a portion of the lands known as Piney Mountain Park, and being described by meters and bounds on a plat made by Brodie & Bedell, Engrs, dated August 30th, 1913, (Plat not yet recorded) and being known and designated as lots # 86-87-88-89-90-92-93-94-95-96-97-98-99-100-101 and 102, according to the plat hereinafore referred to; and being a part of the land conveyed to Piney Mountain Land Co. by W.
