TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and its successors heirs and assigns forever.

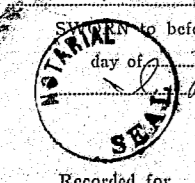
