FIRST: The names and residences of the said petitioner to be as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed corporation be that of Jones Hardware Company

THIRD: The principal place of business of the corporation will be Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: The general purpose of the corporation, and the nature of business it proposes to do.

As hardware merchants dealing in hardware, farming implements and such other goods as they may choose to carry.

FIFTH: The amount of the capital stock to be Seventy Thousand Dollars, and the number of shares into which the same is to be divided to be One Hundred

SIXTH: The capital stock to be payable as set forth in the Declaration and Petition.
