KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Mary L. Pack

in consideration of the sum of  
One Hundred dollars and other valuable considerations,  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Lucy L. Weindman

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Lucy L. Weindman, his heirs and assigns, all of that tract of land situate in Butler Township, in said County and State and described as follows: Beginning at a stone 3x at corner of lands of Mrs. Miller and Sullivan, and runs thence S. 69.41 N. 2327 feet to stone thence N. 20.02 W. 1344 feet to a corner of corner of Miller, thence S. 69.50 W. 1518 feet to a corner of Miller, thence S. 46.40 W. 1791 feet to a stone; thence S. 61.45 W. 737 feet to a stone across the branch; thence S. 34.10 E. crossing the branch 2240 feet to a stake; thence S. 53.45 W. 1129 feet to a corner double hickory; thence S. 37.05 E. 2700 feet to a pile of rock corner; thence N. 33.10 E. 7747 feet to the beginning corner containing according to the survey and blue print of W. D. News, June 21, 1917 four hundred and twenty (424) four acres more or less and being the same land conveyed to me by L. J. Jennings, the 20th day of April 1917 and recorded in Vol. 46 page 208. As part of the consideration for this conveyance the grantee herein assumes and will pay the ten thousand dollar note and mortgage to the grantor to the Life Insurance Company of Virginia, with interest thereon from August 1st 1919 according to their terms.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Lucy L. Weindman, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I myself My Lucy L. Weindman her do hereby bind heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said heirs and assigns, against heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
