Poe Manufacturing Company, All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, just beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville: Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of David Street with the right of way of the old Greenville and Laurens Railroad (now abandoned) and running thence with said David Street, S. 23-3/4 E., one hundred and thirty three (133) feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the line of lot now or formerly owned Mrs. C. F.
