 Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other Valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by Henry Harrison

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Henry Harrison, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being situate in the County and State aforesaid, containing 266 acres, more or less and lying on Cripple Creek and waters of Reedy River adjoining lands now or formerly belonging to A. M. Gely, J. S. E. Harrison and others and showing the following courses and distances to wit: Beginning at a red oak on road and running thence S. 45 7/8 E. 54.00 to stone on Jenkins Bridges road; thence along said road on a line 64.50 to a stone; thence N. 61 W. 82.00 to a stake in mouth of Cripple Creek thence down said creek as a line to a Sycamore at ford; thence S. 1 1/2 E. 6.42 across creek to the beginning corner and being the same lands conveyed to me by John H. Harrison and Edward Harrison by their deed dated June 12th 1883, and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 00 at page 333.

It is understood and agreed that there is reserved from this conveyance any and all machinery which may be located upon the property above described, the title to the said machinery to remain in the grantor and he to have the right to enter upon the premises and remove therefrom at his pleasure.
