KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. M. Kilgore and Mary M. Kilgore

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Thirty Thousand & no/00 (\$30,000.00)

to see

at and before the sealing of these presents by Howard Caldwell

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said Howard Caldwell, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and situate in the State and County aforesaid on Silders Creek and Being a portion of the Jessie C Kilgore tract of land beginning Silders Creek and running thence N. 55-20 E. 1998 feet to stone; thence N. 19-30 E. 294 feet to stone and Greenville Woodruff Road; thence along said Greenville Woodruff Road S. 50-0 E. 1930 feet to bend; thence continuing along said road S. 39-09 E. 921 feet to bend; thence continuing along said road N. 81- E. 208 feet to bend; thence S. 81-09 E. 1474 feet to bend; thence S. 69-0 E. 164 feet to corner in road; thence leaving said road and running S. 2-50 E. 1562 feet; thence S. 68-30 W. 270 feet to stake; thence S. 12-30 E. 326 feet to stake; thence S. 84-30 W. 388.7 feet; thence S. 13-35 W. 555 feet to Sweet Gum; thence S. 64-20 W. 375 feet to four (4) Water Oaks; thence S. 11-20 W. 378 feet to stake on Silders Creek; thence following Silders Creek as a line to the Beginning corner, as represented by a plat of the same made for Howard Caldwell and recorded in office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book ___, at Page ___, reference being made to said plat for a more particular description of the above described tract of land, said land having been sub-divided into six (6) tracts upon said plat. This said tract of land is made up of three (3) separate conveyances, one of which containing five (5) acres was conveyed by J. M. Kilgore February 25, 1908, by deed recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book 16, Page 529. Another of the tracts is Sixty Three (63) acres conveyed to Mrs. Harry M. Kilgore by J. S. Kilgore, Jr., on the 26th day of March, 1904, and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book 26, page 528. Another portion of the said tract of land is made up of a portion of a conveyance made to Jessie M. Kilgore by M. J. B. Kilgore, et al., by Deed dated April 20th, 1901 and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book 17, Page 103. Said tract of land herein conveyed contains 281.85 acres less the following:

Beginning at a stone on the Greenville Woodruff Road and running thence S. 81-0 W. 1040 to four (4) Water Oaks; thence N. 2-20 W. 251 feet to stake; thence N. 84-10 E. 148.5 feet Fence Post and corner of cemetery; thence N. 73-25 E. 752 feet to stone on Greenville-Woodruff Road; thence with Greenville-Woodruff Road S. 39-09 E. to the beginning corner and containing 6.30 acres, said lot belonging to Pilgrim Church, Class one (1) lot known as the cemetery lot and adjoining the Pilgrim Church Property and tract No. 3, as shown by the plat, herein referred to.
