(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

George R. Mayhack, all that certain piece parcel, or lot of land, situated lying and being in the state and county aforesaid; about one and one half miles north of the city of Greenville, beginning at stake on Mountain View Avenue, 450 feet west of corner of Mountain View Avenue and Townes Street, extension and running along Mountain View Avenue North 79-45 W. 100 to corner of lot no. 7 thence with line of lot no. 7 S. 10-15 W. 170 1/2 feet to an alley thence along alley 579-45 E. 100 feet to corner of lot no. 9 thence with line of lot no. 9 N. 10-15 E. 170 1/2 feet to Mountain View Avenue the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by W.D. Parish and S.C. Tower by deed dated March 5th, 1917, and recorded in Vol 41 Page 598 R.M.C. office for Greenville County S.C. also all that certain tract, piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in the state and county aforesaid about one and one half miles north of the city of Greenville S.C. Beginning at a stake on the north side of Buist Avenue 450 feet W of Buist Avenue and Townes Street extension and running thence along Buist Avenue N. 79-45 W 100 feet to corner of Lot 21 thence with line of lot 21 N 10-15 E 170 1/2 feet to an alley thence with alley 579-45 E 100 feet to corner of lot 23 thence with line of Lot 23 S 10-15 W 170 1/2 feet to Buist Avenue the beginning corner being the same lot conveyed to me by J Ross Hatnahan by deed dated May 5th, 1917 and recorded in Vol. H 3 pp 97 R.M.C. office Greenville County S.C. being further known as Lots 708 and 22 respectively of a subdivision known as Oakland Heights made by W.D. News June 1st, 1911 and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County S.C.
