KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. J. Homer Bramlett of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

Three Thousand

DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Henry A. Parris

(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Henry A. Parris, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and City and County of Greenville, in ward # 1. of said City, on the west side of Echols Street and having the following lines, meters and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on Echols Street, opposite an alley which bounds the north side of property of the City and running thence in a northeasterly direction with Echols Street 50 feet to corner of John Jennings' lot; thence in a northwesterly direction with Jennings' line 105 feet to corner of lot of Mrs. J. H. Watson; thence in a southwesterly direction, parallel with Echols Street 50 feet to line of lot owned by Frank Smith; thence with his line in a southwesterly direction 105 feet to the beginning corner, this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Wm. S. Pirrine, by deed dated 17th day of July, 1919 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for said County and State in Volume # 29 of deeds at page 204, to which reference is hereby made.
