(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Curry, all that lot of land lying and being and situate in County and State aforesaid, containing fifty-nine and seventeen one hundredths acres more or less, being a part of the same land conveyed to me by C. S.
