KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Ila Vaughan Hudson, Addie Vaughan, W. Lee Vaughan, Luther Vaughan and Ernest Vaughan, and A. H. Miller,

for and .....in consideration of the sum of  
Five Dollars.....DOLLARS,

to us.....in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by A. H. Dean

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

A. H. Dean his heirs and assigns: That tract of land in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid on waters of Enoree River, having the following meters and bounds, Beginning at a white oak on Enoree river; thence S. 79° W. 148.2 to poplar; thence S. 34° W. 146.6 feet to birch; thence 74° W. 140 feet to stake; thence S. 89° W. 115.5 feet to sweet gum; thence S. 63½° W. 191.4 to pine; thence S. 87° W. 46.6 to stone; thence S. 7° E. 99 feet to stake; thence S. 29° E. 316.8 feet to stone; thence S. 51° W. 364 feet to Hickory; thence N. 66¼° W. 569 feet to poplar; thence along same course 207 feet to stone; thence S. 54½° W. 151 feet to Sour Wood; thence N. 58° W. 693 feet to stone; thence 24½° E. 940 feet to a stake in road to Greenville; thence along same course 1139 feet to stake in center of Enoree River; thence along the meanders of said river in a S. E. direction to the beginning corner.

This Deed is made to correct an error in description in the deeds to A. H. Miller and to W. J. Edwards recorded in R. M. C. office Greenville County in Vol. 26, page 264 and Vol. 24, page 347. Two of the lines of said tract having been omitted from the description in said deeds, and this description being made from a plat of the W. J. Edwards land made by Brockman in April 1919.
