KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That G. S. E. Brown

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
One Dollar and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by
P. C. Poag and J. J. McSwain

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

P. C. Poag and J. J. McSwain, all of the following lots or
parcels of land in the State and County aforesaid described as follows:
Lot No. 1. Fronting fifty (50) feet on West Washington Street, situated
beyond the Southern Railway, and being a portion of lot No. 14, of
a sub-division of the Henry Mosley estate, as shown by plat
recorded in R. M. C. Office for said State and County in Vol. "L"
page 62, and running back by parallel lines two hundred and fifty-
five (255) feet long, and being the same lot of land conveyed
to me by G. F. Hunt and William Goldsmith, Jr., by deed dated March
30, 1911, by deed duly recorded in above named R. M. C. Office in
Vol. 11, page 388.

Lot No. 2. All those two certain lots or parcels of land as
represented by a sub-division of the Henry Mosley estate,
known as lots nos. 10 and 11, and fronting on a new street
proposed as Elizabeth Street fifty (50) feet each, and running
back by parallel lines one hundred twenty-five (125) feet
to a point, bounded on the west by the lot above mentioned,
and bounded on the east by lots hereafter mentioned, and being
the same parcel of land conveyed to me by J. D. Tannahill on
November 10, 1909, by deed recorded in said R. M. C. Office in
Vol. 11, page 214.

Lot No. 3. Also those three other parcels or lots of land front-
ing on Elizabeth Street fifty (50) feet each, and running back
by parallel lines one hundred twenty-five (125) feet, and known
in a sub-division of the Henry Mosley estate as lots nos. 12, 13,
and 14, as represented by plat of same duly recorded in the
aforesaid R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "A" pages 358-359 and
being the same lots conveyed to me by J. W. Gray, Master, on
July 2, 1912, by deed duly recorded in said R. M. C. Office in
Vol. 14, page 74.
