Lee Coole his heirs and assigns, All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the city of Greenville, State and County aforesaid and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at corner of lot now or formerly of Bryson on Arlington Ave. (formerly Garlington Street) and running with Arlington Ave. forty eight (48) feet to corner of Nannie A. Ellisons lot; thence with Ellison lot sixty three feet five inches (63.5) to corner Mrs. J. E. Boyd's lot; thence with Boyd lot forty feet eight inches (40.8) thence fifty eight (58) feet to corner of J. B.
