(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Jas. R. Crouch, all of those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land, situate lying and being on the north side of Neal Street, in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and further described as follows: Beginning 199 feet west of Jones Street on an iron pin in the margin of Neal Street, running thence with Neal Street N. 76° 26' 50 feet to the corner of Lot No. 15, thence with the line of lot 15 N. 14° E. 217.5 feet; thence S. 86° 26'.51 feet; thence S. 14° 26' about 227.6 feet to the beginning corner, being all of Lot. No. 14 of what is known as Jones Street property conveyed to me as Trustee, by W. C. Cleveland, deed dated Feby. 23, 1912 and recorded in Deed Book 12, page 291 in R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

Also a strip of land five feet wide, on the western side of said Lot 14, and on the eastern side of said Lot 15, coextensive in length with Lots 14 and 15, being that part of said lot 15 which was reserved by me when I conveyed the remainder of Lot 15 to Otis Jamison by my deed of conveyance bearing date the 1st day of May, 1919 and recorded in Vol. 58, page 8 in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, and for a more accurate description thereof of the premises herein described reference is had to a plat of same traced Jan. 8, 1916 from a plat made October, 1909 by W. D. Neves, Civil Engineer, and approved October 22, 1909 by Harry T. Poe, Jr. City Engineer, both plats being recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County. The grantor is authorized, as Trustee, to sell and make titles to the within described premises, and for which said authority reference is had to the deed of declaration of trust, dated Feby. 24, 1912 and recorded in R. M. C. office in Vol. 32, page 358.
