(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

All of that lot of land situate on the west side of Buncombe Street in the City and County of Greenville South Carolina, known as lot No. 1 of the Thomas T. Smith property, and beginning at an iron pipe on said street at corner of the Whitmire Property and running thence 5.5-1.52 W. 93.6 feet to an iron pipe; thence 5.28.43 W. 64.4 feet to a fence post; thence 5.49-5.4 E. 20.8 feet to a fence post; thence N. 33.3-4 E. 14.5 feet to an iron pipe on said Buncombe street; thence N. 34.19 W. along said street 51 feet to the beginning corner, as shown by plat of R. E. Dalton made March 16th 1916, together with perpetual right of way eight feet wide to and from the above described lot to Academy Street referred to in deed by Nannie T. Smith Executrix and D. M. Wood and W. H. Cliles Executors of the last will and testament of Thomas T. Smith deceased, to C. N. and Rose E. Garing dated the 8th day of August 1914 and recorded in Vol. 52 page 1 office of R. M. C. for Greenville County and as shown by plat revised May 1914, this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. L. Rhodes by his deed bearing date October 1st 1919 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in deed book Vol. 54 page 166. As part of the consideration for the above described lot of land the grantees herein agree to pay and do hereby assume the payment of a note and mortgage for the sum of \$6,000.00 given by the grantor to R. T. D. Bates with interest as therein provided from March 23rd 1920, which mortgage is recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Mortgage Book Vol. 49 page 108. The grantees are to pay the City and State and County taxes on the above described lot for the year 1920.
