(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs Lena S. Miller, and her heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County and Township of Greenville, near the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, on Conestee Avenue, and being known as Lot #4 of Cherokee Park according to a plat recorded in Plat Book C. at page 96.

Said lot has a frontage of 60 feet on Conestee Avenue, and runs back a depth of 170 feet and 6 inches on the north line to alley in rear and on the south line 170 feet to Alley in rear, said alley being 15 feet wide.

This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. J. McKinney by deed dated 13th day of May 1918 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Vol. #35 of Deeds, at page 313, to which reference is made.
