(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John H. Landrum, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County and Township of Greenville, about two miles west of Greenville Court House, near Monaghan Mills, and having the following lines, corners and bounds, according to a plat of a subdivision known as Morgan Hill Addition, said plat is recorded in plat book A; at pages 68 and 69 to wit: Beginning at a pine on Morgan Street, joint corner of lots #33-E and 33-F, and running thence N. 74° W. 20 feet to an iron pine tree, N. 82° 34' E. 60 feet to iron pine tree N. 74° E. 20 feet to an iron pine on Morgan Street; thence with Morgan Street S. 82° 34' W. 60 feet to the beginning corner and being known as lot #33-F on the above named plat: this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. C. Bull by deed dated 29th day of July 1918 and recorded in the R. M. L. Office for said County and State in Vol. #35 of Deeds, at page 469 and 468, to which reference is made.
