All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being situate in the County and State aforesaid, and being a portion of the lands this day conveyed to us by J. H. Cochran and known upon a subdivision of the Cochran lands at Tracts Nos. 5 and 6, and containing in the aggregate 49.51 acres, more or less, and being more specifically described, in separate tracts, as follows:

Tract No. 5. Beginning on the Harrison Bridge Road at the corner of Tract No. 1, and running thence along said road N. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 12.61 to a stone; thence N. 15 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 4.83 to a stone; thence N. 73 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 14.50 to a pin on road; thence along said road to center of branch at bridge; thence following said branch as a line along lands of Ben Evans and Tracts Nos. 3 and 4 to a stake on line of Tract No. 1; thence along the line of Tract No. 1 S. 16-25 E. 11.47 to the beginning corner, containing 40.14 acres, more or less.
