following more or less miles and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of a
twenty foot alley, and forty five foot street (known
respectively as Bacot Alley and 6th St.) and running
thence along 6th Street N. 27 1/2 E. Seventy five feet and
six inches to an iron pin; thence S. 62 1/2 E. Seventy five
feet to a point 2 m. thence S. 27 1/2 W. Seventy five feet and
six inches to a point 2 m. on Bacot Alley; thence with
said alley N. 62 1/2 W. Seventy five to the beginning corner;
