all that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Greenville* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles from the City of Greenville, on the north side of Easley Bridge Road, containing 17.00 acres more or less, and having the following course and dimensions according to a survey made by G. M. Tissman Jr. on October 7, 1919: Beginning at an iron post on the Easley Bridge Road 240 feet east of the White Horse Cabin and running thence N. 23-15 W. 180 feet to an iron post; thence S. 71-14 W. 244.5 feet to the White Horse Road; thence with the White Horse Road N. 21-55 W. 720 feet to an iron post on Gordon Street thence with Gordon Street S. 71-15 E. 14.50 feet to an iron post on Florida Avenue; thence with Florida Avenue S. 9-30 E. 639.1 feet to an iron post, corner of J. D. Carroll, thence with Carroll's line S. 69-35 W. 228.8 feet; thence still with Carroll's line S. 14-44 E. 80 feet to iron post; line S. 69-15 E. 44 feet to iron post; thence still with her line S. 17-0 E. 181 feet to iron post on Easley Bridge Road; thence with said road S. 69-44.5 W. 370 feet to the beginning corner, being all that I now own of lots 34-1 and 34-2, as are shown on plats of West Highland recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book 6 pages 1158 and 1159.
