all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Situate lying and being near the city of Greenville in a section known as Nickeltown on a public road leading from the Laurens road and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning on south side of Public road and running thence in a southerly direction 45 feet to a stake and thence in a southerly direction along 66 Staves long 10 feet to an alley; thence along said alley in a northerly direction 25 feet to stake on Public road; thence along said road 15 feet to the beginning. This being a part of lot no 1 of W. C. McDaniel's property according to plat recorded in Plat Book C, page 189.

person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
