near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin near the Easley Bridge Road, reserving a side walk adjoining said Road, thence parallel with said Road S. 45° W. Twenty-five (75) feet to an iron pin, thence S. 45° E. One hundred ninety (190) feet to an iron pin, thence N. 45° E. Seventy-five (75) feet to an iron pin, thence N. 45° W. one hundred ninety (190) feet to the beginning corner, containing 14,250 square feet, more or less, being same lot of land I conveyed to Fannie I.
