in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said A. G. New, his heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
About four miles from Greenville Court House, being same base
described in Deed to my mother Lillie Vassie Gray by H. T. C.
Turner recorded in Volume 39 page 449 R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County. My mother having died leaving her will which was
probated August 23, 1919 and is now on file in Probate Court
Greenville County in Apartment 153, File 12, devising said land
to me and my two brothers, Harry W. Gray and Lawrence M.
Gray, the said Harry W. Gray and Lawrence M. Gray having
conveyed to me their interest, deed recorded in Volume 54, page
151, said R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. Said land has
the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a P. O. on old Bent Bridge Road and running
thence with original line N 57 E. 26.15 to middle of old right of
way of Southern Railroad thence along the center of said old
right of way westwardly to point where old Bent Bridge Road
crossed said right of way thence along said old Bent Bridge
Road eastwardly to the beginning corner containing about
twenty-six (26) acres including the old right of way of the
railroad which the railroad appears to have abandoned.

As a part of the considerations for this deed, the
Grantor, A. G. New by accepting same agrees to assume and

warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A. G. New, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other
person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
