in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. Walter Gray, his heirs and assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Bounded by the lands of A. G. New, Robinson and Mrs.
Beattie, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a stone corner of Mrs. Beattie's land running thence across a settlement road S. 44 E. 30° 80' to a stone Beattie and New's corner, thence N. 33 E. 20° 30' to stone New's corner; thence across the railroad N. 14 W. 32° 00' to maple tree N. 83 W. 7° 80' to persimmon, thence S. 17 E. 97° 20' 60' across railroad to a pine near branch; thence S. 36 E. 100' thence S. 50 1/2 W. 12° 93' to the beginning corner, containing eighty-five (85) acres more or less, according to survey of W. A. Heater, May 23rd 1921, and being a part of the land conveyed to me by Poe and Beattie, deed recorded in Deed Book 53 Page 174, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

It is agreed herein that the grantor, A. G. New reserves to himself, his heirs and assigns, all rights of way here to be acquired by the public roads and by railroads for tracks and that he reserves the rights of way for railroad tracks and other roads over and across said land. Reserving and himself, his heirs and assigns the right to establish in a reasonable manner a good wagon road of sufficient width, so as to have access to the railroad siding on said land and to enter the settlement or neighborhood roads on said land and a road through the property to his other lands. The grantor further reserves to himself, his heirs and assigns, the water power by the streams or brooks crossing the railroad tracks, which water power may be developed by the grantor on said premises from the point of the railroad tracks to the line if the grantor with the privilege to develop said power at any time. The grantor or his heirs or assigns may see fit without any liability to the grantee his heirs or assigns for damages by reason of said development of said water power or the use of said water power by the grantor, his heirs or assigns.

It is hereby provided, however, that if the railroad should finally abandon the use of the right of way through this land, then the grantor intends that said right of way shall revert to the grantee, his heirs and assigns, and not to the grantor, if there be any reversion it is the intention herein to reserve the right of way for railroad tracks as long as rail way uses said right of way, but when the railroad ceases to use the same then the right of way is no longer reserved unto the grantor, and if there is any reversion of same then it shall revert to the grantee his heirs and assigns.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by the same on the day of 19, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book Page.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to the said J. Walter Gray.

Pas heirs and assigns forever.

AND do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. Walter Gray.

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other

person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof, except as to the reservations of rights of way and water power herein made.
