unto the said

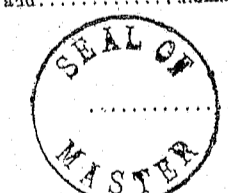
W.C. McDaniel, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate to-wit:
