Circle (a subdivision) of the Thomas L. Woodside heirs' property on  
Rutherford Road, Greenville, South Carolina, as per plat thereof  
made by C. M. Firman, Jr. C. E. March 1920 and recorded in  
the Public Records of Greenville County, South Carolina.*
