Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Twenty Five Hundred Dollars,
to me paid by the said J. B. Wasson
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release
unto the said.

J. B. Wasson, his heirs and assigns forever, they allowing described real
estate, to wit
all that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate, lying and
being in the County and State aforesaid, containing 99 Acres, more
or less, and having the following, thick and rounded,
Beginning at a stone on a branch, corner Sam Harrison's lands, running
thence N. 29 1/4 E. 20.50 chs. to a stone, thence S. 65 1/4 E. 15.83 chs. to
a stone, thence S. 27 1/4 W. 23.96 chs. to a stone, thence S. 60 1/2 E.
18.88 chs. to a stone, thence N. 8 1/2 W. 51.62 to corner on afore named
branch, thence will proceed to beginning corner, as is fully shown by
plat made December 20, 1909 by J. A. Adams, D. C. This tract is bounded
