Whereas Paris Mountain Land Company proposes to improve the roadway leading from Rutherford Road to the lands of said corporation on Paris Mountain, involving the re-location at certain points of said roadway, and Whereas said roadway as re-located will pass through a part of my lands situate on Paris Mountain along the line of the survey for said corporation;

Now, Therefore, Know all men by these presents, that I, W.C. Hamby, of the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of One dollar to me in hand paid, have granted, bargained and conveyed unto the said Paris Mountain Land Company, its successors and assigns, for the purpose of a roadway, a strip of land twenty-five (25) feet in width along the line of said survey with the right to enter upon said strip and to grade the same and to construct a roadway along said strip and do such construction work as may be deemed advisable. Reserving, however, to myself, my heirs and assigns, the right to use the roadway of which the said strip may be a part.

Should the said corporation at any time conclude to turn the said roadway over to the public for use as a public highway, I do hereby consent to such transfer.

Provided, however, that if the said strip of land should become abandoned and cease to be used as a highway, then this deed shall be void, and I, my heirs and assigns, shall have the right to re-enter and take possession of said strip.
