This agreement entered into this day between Henry C. Mayfield, party of the first part and Marnie Johnson party of the second part witnesseth.

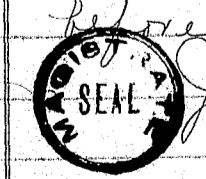
