Know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned, for value received and in consideration of the benefit and advantage of a right of way to and from our real estate, and for this purpose of opening a road way along and in front of the real estate owned by us respectively, do hereby release for said purpose ten feet on the south side of road, deeded March 6<sup>th</sup> 1903, and recorded October 2<sup>nd</sup> 1903, in Book H H H, Page 712. This ten feet being in addition to the ten feet formerly deeded on the south side of the dividing line, thereby making this road thirty feet wide instead of twenty feet as originally deeded, between the land formerly belonging to Jno. S. Coleman, deceased and Hugh Stokes, deceased, running east from Augusta Road and also along the dividing line between the said Hugh Stokes and the land belonging formerly to Charles Hammond, deceased. We further agree, that unless all parties on the south side of the dividing line shall sign this agreement the same shall not be binding on any of the parties.

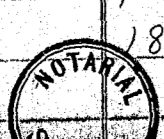

Know all men by these presents that I Nancy Waldrop, Wife of John E. Waldrop of the State and County aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to me paid by George Earle of the State and County aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and release unto the said George Earle, all that tract or boundary of land lying in the State and County aforesaid upon waters of the South Fork of Saluda River, containing twenty-five acres more or less. Having the following boundaries, Beginning on Joseph M. Jenkins' stone corner, on the old Caesar's Head Road, Running south to a stone corner with Ray Gowen's line. Thence west to the Caesar's Head Road to black gum, Thence up the said road to a stone thence with William M. Jenkins line to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights mentioned to the said land, belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said George Earle his heirs and assigns forever. And I hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said land and premises unto the said George Earle his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs and all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim any part thereof.
