Wood, his heirs and assigns forever} right, title and interest which we may now have or which we may in any manner hereafter acquire under item three of the will above referred to, in and to the following described premises.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina about three miles east of the city of Greenville on the Lowndes Hill Road, adjoining lands now or formerly belonging to H. C. Markley and Jack Clyce, containing between forty

and fifty acres and being the same tract of land devised to the said David W. Wood by the will of John W. Wood recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate for Greenville county in will Book "H" pages 107-110.

We further assign and transfer to the said David W. Wood any interest which we may have or which we may hereafter acquire under item three of said will in the proceeds from the sale of said land.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments, and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident to appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said David W. Wood, his heirs and assigns forever.

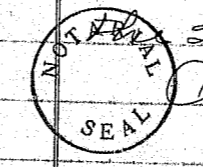
