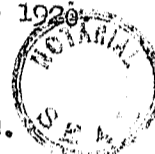

Whereas, heretofore Woodside Cotton Mills Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville, South Carolina, took over and now owns all of the real estate, buildings, machinery and property of Fountain Inn Manufacturing Company, a corporation under the laws of said State, and having its principal place of business in said County and State;

And whereas said Fountain Inn Manufacturing Company was duly dissolved as a corporation on the 18th, day of December 1918, the certificate of dissolution being recorded in Vol. DDD, page 534;

And whereas by authority as contained in Section 2815 of Vol. 1, Code of laws of South Carolina, 1912, the Board of Directors of said corporation, at the time of said dissolution, have full power to convey the property of said corporation to the said Woodside Cotton Mills Company.

Now know all men by these presents, that Fountain Inn Manufacturing Company, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, with its principal place of business at Fountain Inn in said State, and J.F. McKelvey, Kerr Wilson, J.D. Woodside, E.F. Woodside and John T. Woodside as Trustee of said granting corporation, under the laws aforesaid, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration to it and them in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by Woodside Cotton Mills Company, a corporation (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Woodside Cotton Mills Company, its successors and assigns, the following lots of land, with all buildings, property and machinery thereon situate, as belonging to the grantors herein, to-wit:
