 having the following boundaries; Beginning on rock
 (George Earle's corner) on the Casare Head road,
 thence down said road to a Black Gum; thence
 west to Hog Branch to a Maple corner; thence up
 Hog Branch to a White Oak, thence East with William
 McJunkin's line to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights mentioned
 to the said land belonging or in anywise appertaining
 to have and to hold all and singular the said
 premises unto the said William McJunkin his
 heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind
 myself, my Heirs, Executors, and Administrators to
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the
 said land and premises unto the said William
 McJunkin his heirs and assigns against my-
 self and my heirs and all other persons whomso-
 ever lawfully claiming or to claim any part
 thereof.

 County State aforesaid, upon waters of South Fork
 Saluda River, containing Twenty five acres more
 or less, and hath the following boundaries:

Beginning on a stone on old Casare Head Road,
 running with Joseph McJunkin's line to Hog
 Branch, thence down Hog Branch to a White Oak
 on a Cliff, thence a straight line North East
 course to the beginning corner.
