 We, The John Bright Shoe Company lessor, in consideration of the rental hereinafter mentioned, have granted, bargained and released, and by these presents do grant bargain and lease unto Blanche Mc Knight lessee the Store Room, ground floor only, being one half of the original room said rooms being No. 114 East side of North Main Street, Greenville City, South Carolina, for the term of five years and one month beginning Oct 1st, 1922 and ending Oct 31st, 1927, and the said lessee in consideration of the use of said premises for the said term, promise to pay to the said lessor the sum of Seventy six hundred, and twenty five ^{no}100 Dollars for the full term of lease payable in monthly installments of One hundred and twenty five dollars each - payable monthly in advance beginning October the first day 1922 and continuing thereon until the expiration of said lease. The lessors agree to build Lavatory and Toilet in the above store room.

It is understood and agreed that this lease is now given by the lessors and taken by the lessee subject to the terms and conditions of the lease given by Irene M. Baker to the lessor dated July 25, 1922.

To Have and to Hold the said premises unto the said lessee her executors, administrators, and assigns for the said term. It is agreed by the parties hereto that this lease shall continue only until above expiration. But the destruction of the premises by fire or other casualty or One months arrear of rent shall terminate this lease. The lessee agree to make good all breakage of glass, and all other injuries done to the premises during the term, except such as are produced by natural decay and unavoidable accidents and agree to make no repairs improvements

or alterations in the premises without the written consent of the lessor
