Greene, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, near Brandon Mills, and known as lot No. 22 of Providence Subdivision, according to plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 411, said lot having a frontage on Pendleton Street extension of 20 feet and running back in parallel lines a distance of 73 feet from said extension, and bounded on the North by property of D. B. Trapier and C. F. Haynesworth, on the East by lot No. 21, on the south by Pendleton Street extension, and on the west by lot No. 23.

Also that other lot of land adjoining the above and known as lot No. 23 as shown on the above mentioned plat, Beginning on the north side of Pendleton Street extension at the corner of lot No. 24, and runs thence in a northerly direction with line of said lot 46 feet to a stake on the right-of-way, of the Southern Railway Company; thence with said right-of-way in a northerly direction 48 feet to a stake corner of lot No. 22; thence with line of said lot in a southerly direction 73 feet to a stake on said extension; thence with said extension 40 feet in a westerly direction to the beginning corner.
