Workman of Greenville City and County (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. D. Workman, his heirs and assigns forever;

All my right, title and interest in and to all plants, mills, and machinery and fixtures now on the aforesaid tract of land, together with all of my rights, title and interest of, in and to the dam now across said river with the right to maintain the same and with all water rights incident and connected with the dam and the 357 acres this day conveyed by me to W. D. Workman, one end of said dam resting on the east side of said river. Also all the rights of any nature whatsoever which I may have acquired by the deeds above referred to in the premises of this deed.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W. D. Workman, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. D. Workman, his

heirs and assigns, against me my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
