Moore of the City of Bluefield in the State of West Virginia in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations one DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Moore Milling Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Moore Milling Company,

All that lot of land situate in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville about 1 1/2 miles from Greenville Court House on the Augusta Road containing 8 1/4 acres more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the west side of Augusta Road and running thence 36 1/2 N. 1655 feet to a stake 340 thence S. 41 3/4 E. 263 1/2 feet thence N. 54 1/2 East 1585 feet to Augusta Road, thence N. 25 1/2 N. 212 feet along said road to the beginning. This being the same lot conveyed to me by S.O. Skelton by deed dated December 1918, recorded in Vol. 57 page 318.

As part of the consideration for this conveyance the grantee assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on a note and mortgage covering said property executed by me in favor of the said S.O. Skelton in amount of \$2700.00, recorded in Vol. 69, page 168, G. M. C. Records for Greenville County.
