TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Mrs. Ruth Beck, James Ralph Fuller and Annie May Fuller

on or about the 4th day of August in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and seventeen exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Myrtle Eleura Fuller

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 16th day of August 1917, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to G.W. Bishop for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 7457)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$1062.50 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said G.W. Bishop, All the right, title and interest of Myrtle Eleura Fuller in and to the following described real estate:

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone northwest x of farm, and is also corner of the Pool farm; thence S. 23-1/4 W. 31.50 ch. to a stake in old road; thence along old road S. 50 E. 5.17 ch. to angle in road; thence S. 53 E. 2.50 to angle in road; thence S. 52 E. 3.00 ch. to angle in road; thence S. 62-1/2 E. 2.45 ch. to a stake; thence N. 29-1/4 E. 9.43 ch. to an iron pin; thence S. 61-3/4 W. 2.34 ch. to stake in branch; thence up and with the meanders of said branch as a line 19.56 ch. to an iron pin in center of branch; thence N. 9 W. 4.70 ch. to stake in center of said branch; thence N. 54 W. 13.44 ch. to the beginning corner and containing Fifty (50) acres."

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said G.W. Bishop, his heirs and assigns forever.
