HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said \_\_\_\_\_

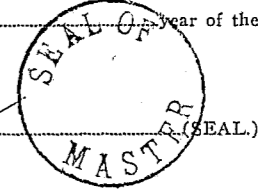
R. Perry Turner and C. M. Ponder, their heirs and assigns forever, the
