HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said.....

J. I. Brown and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:  
All that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in County and State aforesaid on the bank waters of Camp Creek and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on a rock corner on the west side of road leading to M. L. Brown's residence, thence running in a straight line in a westerly direction to a pine on or near Mrs. Wall's line; thence in a southerly direction along Mrs. Wall's line to school house line; thence along school house line to a rock corner near old road leading from Camp Creek and by E. M. Hightower's residence thence along said old road in an easterly direction to road leading to M. L. Brown's residence; rock corner; thence along said road to beginning corner containing ten acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.
