Office of Greenville County in Plat Book E page 116 and having the following Metes and Bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Opal Avenue, joint corner of Lots nos. 5 and 6 and running thence with Opal Avenue S. 79.43 W. 53.8 feet to a stake; thence S. 0.11 W. 150 feet to a stake; thence N. 83.17 E. 54 feet to a stake; thence N. 0.20 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.
