G.F. Norris and A.F. McKissick and their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that certain lot of land situated on the west side of North Laurens Street in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on said North Laurens Street which is 100 feet from the north side of W. North Street and runs thence in a northerly direction along Laurens Street 71.75 feet to an iron pin at the corner of the McCrorey lot; thence in the line of that lot in a westerly direction and parallel with North Street 106 feet to the Beattie Lot; thence along the line of that lot in a southerly direction 71.75 feet to an iron pin; thence in a straight line to the beginning corner, and being the same land conveyed to G.J. Douglass by L.I. Jennings, by deed recorded in Vol. 27, page 560, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina. As a part of the consideration for the premises herein conveyed the grantees assumed the payment of a note and mortgage given by Harry Lee Douglass Chapman, as Administratrix of the estate of G.J.
