WHEREAS, Mollie J. Glenn

our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty exhibited her complaint in the Court
of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against
Ellison G. Glenn and Grace Glenn Ray

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 4th day of
day of December 1920 and on 5th day of August, 1921, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it
was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by C. Inman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to E. Agnes Webster
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No.)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, C. Inman
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said.....

E. Agnes Webster, his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of Grace Glenn Ray in and to all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township Greenville County, and state of South Carolina, about two miles from Greenville Court House, lying South of the Lawrence Road, and being more fully described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the road, which pin is the corner of land already owned by the said Webster, and run thence along the center of said road, S. 27. 23 W. 700 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 88 W. 3552 feet, crossing a branch to an iron pin on Reedy River; thence N. 57. 15 E. crossing the branch three times, 1471 feet to a poplar tree to and north east of said branch at the corner of the land of said Webster; thence S. 79 E. 171. 5 feet thence S. 88 E. 2053 feet to the beginning corner, containing 48.02 acres, more or less.

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TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.
