(1/6) interest therein, in and to "All that certain lot of
land situate on the north side of East North street
in the City and County of Greenville State of South
Carolina, fronting on said street 75 feet, more or less
and having a depth of 204 feet more or less, and bounded
by lands of Rector, Austin and others."

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same;
and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said R. H. Johnson and
his (s) heirs and assigns forever.
