TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Inman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Edgar S. Greene and William A. Greene, as Executors of the last will and testament of Mrs. Flora L. Greene, deceased, Annie L. Greene and William A. Greene

on or about the 13th day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty one exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Floride M. Greene, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th day of March 1921, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Floride M. Greene

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. _____)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the 'said

Floride M. Greene and her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:
"All that certain tract of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, about 11 miles from Greenville, containing 26.70 acres, more or less, as shown on a sub. division and plat of the estate of Luther L. Greene, deceased, made by W. A. Christopher, Surveyor in September, 1921, and revised by B. E. Dalton, in December, 1922, and being known and designated on said plat as Tract No. 8. This tract was allotted to Floride M. Greene by the Commissioners in partition as shown by their Report to the Court. Said tract has the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at a point in the center of the Greenville and Laurens Road, at the south-east corner of Tract No. 7, and running thence along the center of said road, S. 51.25 E. 4.32 to a point at the intersection of said road and the Mauldin Road, near the former home of Luther L. Greene, deceased; thence along the center of said Mauldin road and along the line of Tract No. 1, N. 65.45 E. 8.70 to an iron pin; thence continuing along the center of said road, N. 73.45 E. 7.45 to an iron pin; thence N. 14.10 E. 2.92 to an iron pin in the center of the Old Reese Road; thence continuing along the center of said road, N. 13.32 E. 3.02 to an iron pin; thence continuing along the center of said road, N. 16.30 E. 3.81 to an iron pin in the center of said road; thence continuing along the center of said road, N. 20.30 E. 2.24 to an iron pin; thence along the line of last mentioned tract, S. 16.30 W. 13.66 to Old Reese Road corner."

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Floride M. Greene and her heirs and assigns forever.
