Inman, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$700.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Clayton and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Greer, County and State aforesaid, on the south side of Maud street and being known and designated as lot No. 3 on a sub-division and plot of the M. J. Haines lots made by W. A. Christopher Surveyor, on the 14th day of May 1923, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances to-wit: Beginning at the corner of lot No. 2 on Maud Street, and running thence along the line of said street S. 75.15 W. 70 feet to the corner of lot No. 4; thence along the line of lot No. 4 S. 15 E. 20 feet; thence N. 75.15 E. 70 feet to the corner of lot No. 2; thence along the line of lot No. 2 N. 13 W. 20 feet to the beginning point on Maud street and being a part of the land conveyed to the late Minnie Rebecca Haines by Noah Garrison by deed dated May 21, 1907, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for the County and State aforesaid, in Deed Book, Vol. 8, Page 202.
